RULES: Shooting will be in accordance with GNAS rules and all Archers must be GNAS affiliated. Please show your GNAS membership card at registration. End timings will follow method 1 as stated in Rule 304, part f, of the GNAS Rules of Shooting.

EQUIPMENT INSPECTION: Starting from 8:45, please take all shooting equipment to the Judges for inspection, once you are setup.

DRESS CODE: In accordance with the dress regulations - no denim or camouflage clothing.

TESTING: Archers will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply; if they refuse that refusal can be treated as a positive result. Written parental consent must be provided for JUNIORS.

AWARDS: Gold, Silver and Bronze for Gents, Ladies and Juniors in Recurve, Compound, Longbow and Barebow classes subject to number of entries; Gold, Silver and Bronze handicap medals subject to entries

WHEELCHAIRS: So that we can allocate sufficient space on the shooting line, please indicate on the entry form if you require access for a wheelchair.

BOSSSES : We will be using new and nearly new traditional straw bosses on 3-legged frames.

REFRESHMENTS: Bacon butties will be available before the shoot and at lunch time if ordered on the morning. Tea/Coffee, cakes, biscuits etc will be available throughout the day.

LATE ENTRIES & REFUNDS We are restricted on target numbers so a "waiting list" will be kept if needed. Refunds will be available for cancelations before the closing date. Sorry - no refunds will be provided for cancelations after the closing date or for archers who are not able to attend on the day. Substitutes, providing they shoot the same round, are perfectly acceptable providing details are notified before the day.

CAR PARKING: Ample car parking is available.

CHILD PROTECTION/PHOTOGRAPHY: MVB have implemented a Child Protection Policy which will be applied as appropriate at this event, including requiring those wishing to take photos or videos to provide their details on a contact sheet on arrival.
