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The Course charge is **£75.00** to cover all club costs including equipment usage and refreshments. In order to secure a place on the course a non-refundable deposit of **£25.00** is to be paid at least **6** weeks prior to the first session and the remainder must be paid before the first session. If you prefer, payment in full may be made at time of booking.

Terms and Conditions

- An application form must be completed and sent to the membership secretary to register for a place on the course
- Your non-refundable deposit must be paid to secure your place at least 6 weeks before the start of the course. Your place may be reassigned if this deposit is not received.
- The entire course fee must be paid in full prior to the start of the first session.
- Once the course has commenced all course fees are non-refundable.
- Each course will normally comprise 4 sessions of 2 – 3 hours spread over a period of 2 – 3 weeks. Students must attend all planned sessions in order to complete the course, they will not be able to defer a session or arrange catch up sessions.

- All medical conditions relevant to participating safely in the sport of archery must be disclosed on the course application form, at the time of application. (*We do not discriminate on any medical condition we only require this information to ensure that relevant safety measures are in place for all course attendees. All medical information relevant to you completing a course is held in the strictest confidence and is only disclosed to the coaches/helpers teaching you*).
- Attending a Beginners course does not automatically entitle you to membership of the Bowmen of Warfield Archery club. Rather, membership is by invitation upon full and successful completion of a Beginners course.



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- All juniors (under 18) attending must be accompanied by a Parent or Guardian who must remain present throughout the duration of each session of the course.
- All coaching and shooting will be strictly in accordance with GNAS rules, regulations and practice. Any contravention of shooting or safety rules could result in immediate suspension from the lesson.
- The Bowmen of Warfield reserve the right to exclude students from a Beginners course altogether should they persistently disobey the safety instructions or Rules of Shooting.
- The Bowmen of Warfield cannot accept any responsibility for damage or injury sustained whilst entering, or leaving, the ground.

Note: Persons on a course are expected to obey the rules of the Club and the safety guidelines at all times and to treat the facilities with the greatest respect. The Club is affiliated to the Archery GB (Grand National Archery Society), The Southern Counties Archery Society and the Berkshire Archery Association, all of whom have a code of conduct and a set of regulations. Our coaches will issue instructions to course delegates based upon these guidelines, codes and regulations and these instructions must be complied with at all times.

All information on this form will be kept strictly private. We will not pass this information on to any third party. The information will be removed and destroyed 3 calendar months after course completion. This code of practice reflects the requirements of the GDPR.
